

CHAP. 156.—An ACT authorizing the payment of a sum of money to Oliver Snead of the county of Russell.

[Passed February 21, 1845.]

1. *Be it enacted by the general assembly,* That the auditor of public accounts be, and he is hereby authorized and required to issue his warrant on the treasury, payable out of any money therein not otherwise appropriated, for the sum of fourteen dollars, in favour of Oliver Snead of the county of Russell, being for services rendered by him as drummer to the seventy-second regiment of Virginia militia, for the years eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, and eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, the claim for which services (having been lost or mislaid) was not presented to the auditor for payment within the time prescribed by law.

Sum allowed Oliver Snead as drummer to 72d regiment.

2. This act shall be in force from the passing thereof.

CHAP. 157.—An ACT concerning John Patteson of the county of Buckingham.

[Passed February 20, 1845.]

1. *Be it enacted by the general assembly,* That the auditor of public accounts be and he is hereby authorized and required to issue his warrant on the treasury in favour of John Patteson of the county of Buckingham, for the sum of twenty-four dollars in consideration of services rendered by said Patteson in the year seventeen hundred and eighty-one, while detached (by his commanding officer captain Holcombe) on a foraging expedition.

Sum allowed John Patteson for revolutionary services.

2. This act shall be in force from the passing thereof.

CHAP. 158.—An ACT in favour of Mrs. Nestell the widow of Peter Nestell, a revolutionary officer.

[Passed February 13, 1845.]

1. *Be it enacted by the general assembly,* That instead of the sum of one hundred dollars now paid to Mrs. Mary Nestell, widow of Peter Nestell, an officer of the revolution and member of the Cincinnati society, out of the interest of the Cincinnati society fund, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars per annum during her life be, and the same is hereby directed to be paid to the said Mary Nestell, out of the interest of the said fund by the proper officers, in semi-annual instalments, at the same time and in like manner in all respects as the sum of one hundred dollars per annum has heretofore been paid her; the first payment of one hundred and twenty-five dollars to be paid her at the period when the next semi-annual payment of her pension heretofore allowed would have become payable.

Pension of Mary Nestell increased.

2. This act shall be in force from the passing thereof.

Commencement.

CHAP. 159.—An ACT authorizing the payment of a sum of money to B. Chamberlayne as clerk to the committee of claims at the last session of the general assembly.

[Passed February 21, 1845.]

1. *Be it enacted by the general assembly,* That the auditor of public accounts be, and he is hereby authorized and required to issue his warrant on the treasury, payable out of any money therein not otherwise appropriated, in favour of Byrd Chamberlayne, for the sum of one hundred and eighty-five dollars, for services as clerk to the committee of claims at the last session of the general assembly.

Sum allowed B. Chamberlayne for services as clerk to committee of claims.

2. This act shall be in force from the passing thereof.
